# Explore the Benefits of our Commercial Electric Weatherization Program



Keep your business comfortable while reducing energy costs. We offer financial incentives for weatherization upgrades that improve energy efficiency and help lower energy bills.

## Program Benefits

- Improved HVAC efficiency by preventing heated and cooled air from escaping
- Increased sustainability and decreased maintenance costs
- Assistance through all phases, from planning to design

## Electric Program Eligibility

### Your facility must:

- Be an electric customer on a qualifying commercial rate that pays the System Benefits Charge (SBC)
- Use electric heat, such as a heat pump, or electric resistance heating, as your building's primary heating source
- Use a delivered fuel, such as oil, propane, or wood, as your building's primary heating source

**Not eligible:** Customers using utility-delivered natural gas as their primary heating source are not eligible. Please contact your natural gas provider for weatherization incentives.

## Programs and Financial Incentives



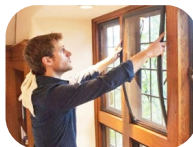
**Pipe Insulation**  
Up to \$6/linear ft



**Air Sealing**  
Up to \$6/linear ft



**Window Replacement**  
Up to \$8/sq ft



**Window Inserts**  
Up to \$3.50/sq ft



**Roof/Wall Insulation**  
Up to \$4/sq ft



**Exterior Door Replacement**  
Up to \$17/sq ft



**Air Curtains**  
Up to \$3,000/unit

Additional weatherization measures such as insulation for pipe components, storm windows, floor insulation, and duct sealing may be eligible for a custom incentive, offering up to \$0.20/kWh or up to 70% of project costs (max incentive of \$150,000 per project).

Extra incentives may be available for disadvantaged communities and passive buildings. Contact your National Grid representative for more information.
